Market

This event come under the Preloved Clothing Market banner. That Market is one that brims with quality preowned fashion and accessories for avid bargain hunters. A Market that offers a friendly informal community for preloved clothing sellers to get seen by local shoppers.

This Preloved Uniform Market is hosted in the same community spirit – offering an opportunity for the reselling and purchase of quality second-hand school gear.

Venue

The Preloved Uniform Market is held at the **Uniting Church Hall, 2 Swan Street, North Hobart** (opposite the North Hobart Post Office, and behind the Born in Brunswick Café on Elizabeth Street).

When

The Winter Preloved Uniform Market is **10-2pm on Saturday, 7 April, 2018.**

Set Up Time

Registration to sell opens at 8.30am and set up concludes at 9.45am.

The Market opens to buyers at 10am. It ends at 2pm, with hall access ending at 3pm.

Sellers are responsible for their items at all times, and should expect to be on hand at the Market to sell them.

Parking

There is no parking available on site – please utilise the various parking facilities in the North Hobart vicinity.

Refreshments

Tea, coffee and biscuits is available (in the kitchen) for sellers.

Re hot drinks - it is advised that you bring your own lidded cup (a keep cup or such like) as there may be young children at the market.



How to join as a seller

- Bring items at set up: 8.30 to 9.45am
- On arrival, register at front desk –
- To register as a seller it is \$5, payable at registration (discount for 4 or more)
- Ideally your items will already be labelled (as noted *)
- Spare labels/pins will be available if required – at a small cost
- You'll be allocated to a table to display your items
- Racks and tables are supplied for communal use
- A group of registering sellers may request a dedicated table/rack – this can be arranged at the discretion of the organisers depending on availability, and ideally prior to market day by booking on the Preloved Clothing Market website <http://www.prelovedclothing.com.au/> or by contacting info@prelovedclothing.com.au
- Sellers are responsible for having small change available, and securing their own takings
- Sellers are responsible for their own sale items at all times

Once you have registered as a seller you are **welcome to shop** as well (naturally)!

*IMPORTANT - labelling your items

There will be many items, and possibly in similar colours, styles and sizes so **it is a condition of registering to sell at this event that your items for sale are clearly and securely labelled** – ideally pinned or tied to the item.

Market organisers are unable to take responsibility for misplaced items, disputes over items, or items that become orphaned, as a consequence of lost or inadequate labelling.

Labels should include plenty of information, and at minimum:

- NAME - initials/name of seller
- SCHOOL
- SIZE - where relevant
- PRICE

Quality

Please only bring items that are in a condition you would buy them - clean, in good repair and of quality.

What you can sell

Items for sale may include quality:

- Uniform items
- School shoes
- School Bags
- School accessories
- Text Books
- School sports gear
- School musical instruments
